

Bed bugs generally prefer to live in tight spaces that are dark and hidden. Look for cracks and crevices in your furniture and your room. Inspect every inch of your room for any possible bed bug hiding spots. If you're able to find all their hiding spots, you'll succeed at destroying every last bed bug.

Bed bugs are tiny insects (eggs: 1/16 inch, adults 3/16-1/4 inch long), broadly oval, flat, brown to reddish-brown color, with a 3-segmented beak, 4-segmented antennae, and 6 legs. They have very thin, flattened bodies covered with short, yellow-colored hairs. Bed bugs cannot fly, but can only walk. They give off a distinctive "musty-sweetish" odor, due to certain "alarm" chemicals that are produced by their glands.

? WHY THIS STEP IS CRUCIAL

Bed bugs are very persistent and resilient insects that **infest bedroom area**. Whereby there are several treatment methods available it is best to use such that ensures a high kill efficiency for bed bugs and **minimal health risks** for the bedroom occupants.

BED BUG EXTERMINATION SPRAY

Say Bye Bugs is a proven bed bug destroyer that kills bed bugs on contact and leaves no odor or stains. It uses ingredients that react violently with bed bug's exoskeleton killing it on contact. It's however safe - for pets and people, when used as directed. This is possible because it uses ingredients that are made from biodegradable materials and not toxic to any living species other than bed bugs and other home insects such as fleas, mites, ants, etc.

TO USEINSTRUCTIONS TO USE

SHAKE WELL before spraying. For best effect spray twice daily on all areas of use for a minimum of two weeks or until the infestation persists. 14 days is a period in which the newly laid bed bug eggs hatch and larvae start to walk around, coming out of their hideouts, thus revealing themselves to us for the kill. Since eggs can be hidden almost anywhere, even in unreachable areas, treatment is needed for a minimum of 14 consecutive days. This is the only way to truly kill all bed bugs - also the ones that were left in hiding or hatching - and to minimize the possibility of a reinfestation. No need to vacate the room or home during treatment.

STEP 1: SPRAY



Say Bye Bugs spray is intended for **indoor commercial and residential use**. For active bed bug outbreaks and travels. Kills bed bugs in all stages of development (eggs, nymphs, and adults).

Spray is **usable on all water-safe surfaces**. For best effect **spray all potentially infested areas** that include: pillows, mattresses, box springs, bed frames, headboards, bed rails, closets, carpets, furniture, purses, briefcases, luggage, and all other cracks and crevices where a bed bug may hide. Don't forget to spray below drawers, on drawer slides, behind cabinets, behind window molding, behind mirrors and picture frames, and behind nightstands and side tables. You only need to spray a light mist on these areas to immediately eliminate the bed bugs lurking there.

Note that the formula does not provide a residual effect.







? WHY THIS STEP IS CRUCIAL

Spray only works on surface areas and on bed bugs it comes in direct contact with. **Yet many of these insects hide in hard-to-reach or hidden areas in linen and clothes where they harbor and reproduce.** The most efficient way to treat them is to simply **wash these items using a dedicated detergent for the highest efficiency**.

DEDICATED BED BUG LAUNDRY DETERGENT

Say Bye Bugs laundry detergent offers a concentrated dose of bed bug killing formula to eliminate bed bugs on linens, clothes and other washable items. It is completely scent and odor free, and its only task is to destroy all bed bugs, their eggs and their offspring. This detergent will also eradicate other common pests located in your textiles such as lice, mites, etc. After a blood meal during the night, bed bugs hide in various areas of your bedroom. This does not exclude your clothes stored in your drawers, wardrobes or laying around. Use Say Bye Bugs laundry treatment to destroy every bed bug – including eggs that have contaminated your sheets, clothes and other textiles.

INSTRUCTIONS TO USE

Sort the laundry prior to washing in the same manner as if conducting your normal laundry cycle. Say Bye Bugs Laundry Detergent can be **used independently or combined with other detergents** in automatic or manual dispensing system. Usable with HE machines (extra rinsing may be required). The first thing you'll need to do is to **immediately put all of your bedding, including sheets, pillow covers, comforter, duvet, and other textiles found in your bedroom into plastic garbage bags**. Seal them up to prevent any bed bugs from escaping to other parts of your home, thus containing the

infestation and preventing its resurgence later on. Bring your garbage bags to your washing machine and be very careful in transferring the bedding and clothes into the machine. Put the garbage bags, one at a time, directly in front of the machine and unload the bedding and clothes right into it. Wash the bedding and clothes using the Say Bye Bugs laundry detergent with the hottest water your fabrics permit. When the bedding and clothes are washed, put them in the dryer using the highest temperature your fabrics permit. Don't overstuff the dryer; only fill the dryer halfway to allow every item of clothing and bedding to receive adequate heat exposure. Leave the clothes in the dryer for at least 45 minutes. The heat, combined with the specially formulated laundry detergent, will eliminate every bed bug, even their eggs. After washing and drying, seal your sheets and clothes into new plastic bags or containers. You want to make sure that there is no possibility of re-exposure. Store the treated textiles in another room that is not infested with bed bugs. Hold clothes that you regularly wear in airtight plastic bins in your room. Clothes that were hanging in your closets don't usually need to be treated or sealed, unless your room has a serious bed bug infestation.

? WHY YOU NEED THIS STEP

After spraying and washing all the visible surfaces the **only thing that are left are cracks and crevices**. Those areas are **best treated with a dedicated and powerful tool** that will pull them and contain them in a safe area.

DESCRIPTION

Disgusted by having to Hand Pick Bed Bugs and Their Leftovers? Use the Bed Bug Sucker and You Never Need to Touch Them Again! This handy tool will gather, isolate and confine your bed bugs in one separate area for a safe removal. Whereby common household vacuums will be somehow effective, we recommend a dedicated bed bug vacuum for medium to big infestations. Why? This bed bug sucker was designed to be used for bed bug treatments as a way to safely collect bed bugs and their eggs within cracks and crevices into self-contained HEPA bag filters. It holds powerful 1,400 Watt sucking power ensuring no insect can escape its pull. A self-contained high efficiency particulate air (HEPA) bag filters warrant that even the tiniest captured eggs measuring a meager 1/16 inch of a size can't escape. The 'backpack' ergonomic fit mobile design with its weight of only 10 pounds enables you to carry it around exactly where you need it. A telescopic wand, together with a set of five different attachments ensures you can treat just about any surface or crack where you suspect bed bugs may be hiding. Various accessories enable you to reach all tight spaces in your home. It can be adjusted to left- or right-hand operation and easily converts to a blower providing an extra cleaning dimension for later use. The vacuum can capture everything from bugs to dirt and debris, so you can use it for years after being rid of bed bugs.

STEP 3: EXTRACT



AREA OF USE

First, start with your mattress and box springs. Use the vacuum to suck up bed bugs, shells, fecal droppings, or eggs along the mattress seams, pillows, and box springs. Vacuum slowly and carefully so to suck up all the traces of the bed bug infestation. Next, use your vacuum on your bed or bed frame. Pay special attention to your headboard, footboard, the metal frame, and inside cracks and crevices. Check the wood and metal joints of your bed for hidden bed bugs and eggs. Use your vacuum cleaner on the edges of carpet, behind mirrors and picture frames, inside books and magazines, and other small, dark, and hidden spaces. Vacuum wood cracks on furniture and baseboards, underneath rugs, and inside drawers. Use the narrow attachments on your vacuum to completely clear out tight spots.

TO USEINSTRUCTIONS TO USE

This will **drastically reduce the bed bug population** in your room and make it much harder for bed bugs to hide. After you've vacuumed everything seal off the end of the hose with the supplied orange cap, move to a safe location, replace the filter bag on the vacuum. Clean the canister as well. This will prevent the re-exposure of bed bugs to other parts of your home. Finally, reapply Say Bye Bugs spray on the areas you've vacuumed. This will ensure that any bed bugs left on the surface due to your movement are eliminated.



STEP 4: SECURE



? WHY YOU NEED THIS STEP

Your bed, with its frames and mattress, contain many areas that even when sprayed, washed and vacuumed **cannot be completely treated due to its material structure** (e.g. multi-layered, loose-textured, fissured, perforated, fragmented, etc.). To avoid needing to replace them and costing your thousands of dollars, you should **simply secure them with bed bug-proof encasements**. This way no bed bug can enter or leave, and you prevent them from hiding ever again in such inconspicuous locations.

DESCRIPTION

A mattress encasement is an insect- and water-proof cover with which you enwrap your mattress, box springs and even your pillow once you're faced with a bed bug infestation. An effective mattress encasement will seal all the bed bugs inside the mattress encasement, preventing them from biting you. It will also prevent bed bugs from escaping, trapping them inside the seal without any access to their food. Without a blood meal available to them, bed bugs will eventually starve to death inside the encasement. Leave the mattress encasements zipped up for at least a year to ensure that every bed bug has died. Say Bye Bugs encasements are completely allergen proof, water resistant and most of all made specifically to contain bed bugs. We've made them very comfortable, so rest assured you'll get a good night's sleep with them. Bed bugs can travel ten feet from where you sleep so cleaning any other hiding spaces under your bed is highly advisable. Any storage boxes or units will need to be removed, since bed bugs can climb on these to reach your bed. For the same reason, a bed skirt should not be used while you're in the process of eliminating bed bugs. If your bed frame is old and has a lot of cracks that cannot be covered with the encasement you might want to consider replacing it with another bed frame until your infestation has been eliminated.

STEP 4: SECURE



TO USEINSTRUCTIONS TO USE

First, remove all bedding and put them in sealed garbage bags. This will hold all bed bugs that were on your bedding and keep them inside. The bed bugs will be sealed up inside the garbage bags and unable to escape. Bring the garbage bags to the washing machine and carefully put your bedding directly into the machine. Wash your sheets with the Say Bye Bugs laundry detergent following the instructions on page 8. Thoroughly vacuum your mattress and box springs to remove all visible evidence of bed bugs and bed bug eggs. Use a powerful vacuum, like the Backpack Vacuum that has the ability to collect and store bed bugs and their eggs in a sealed HEPA filter. (described on page 9). Use the Say Bye Bugs Exterminator spray on your mattress and box springs, especially around the seams. Try removing the dust cover on the box spring, so you'll be able to spray inside. Allow your mattress and box springs to dry after you've used the exterminator spray and before you put on the mattress encasement. You'll need a mattress encasement for each mattress and box spring that has been infected with bed bugs. When your mattress and box springs are covered with mattress encasements and your bedding has been washed, you may put on your bedding back on the mattress. An important thing to keep in mind is to never leave your mattress or sheets on the floor when you're dealing with a bed bug infestation.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

01 Why do we get bed bugs?

Bed bugs primarily feed on humans, which is why they have adapted to "hitchhike" from one place to another. They cling to clothing, furniture, and other belongings, making it easy for them to spread. Everyday activities like taking a taxi, going to the movies, using public transportation, purchasing second-hand furniture, or staying in hotels and motels all increase the risk of bringing bed bugs into your home. In some cases, they may even travel from a neighboring apartment, finding their way into your living space.

02 What should I do if bed bugs that keep coming back?

Two possible reasons exist for this:

A. Original infestation was never completely removed.

Have you had longer periods (approx. 4 weeks or more) with no bed bugs or bed bug bites? If there were no such periods, the original infestation was most likely reduced, but not completely removed. In such case we recommend abiding to the instructions in this guide and applying all recommended products to ensure a complete infestation removal.



If however there were longer periods with no bed bug (or bed bug bites), then a completely new reinfestation is most likely the problem. In this case you need to remove the existing infestation and implement the following bed bug preventive measures into your lifestyle.


